EDON Place Domestic & Family Violence Centre provides a wide range of Programs & Services.

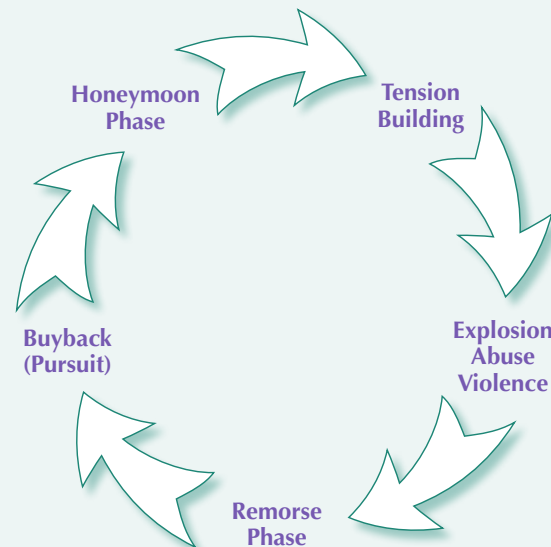
